This winter season change will add 7 days to the East Coast US to Asia product that is currently offered, though there will be no impact on the Asia to East Coast US (750S), nor the Asia to West Coast US or West Coast US to Asia products offered on the butterfly service of TP9 (750E/750W).

The 17 vessel rotation has begun with 703 Albert Maersk 729S on 12 December 2012 in Newark (New Jersey, US), and is expected to continue until March 2013. The service will slow-steam via the Cape of Good Hope during the winter slack season.

WestMed service - No sailing (Week 1 Westbound/Week 3 Eastbound)

Therefore, the first sailing of the New Year is the Cathrine Rickmers, 1218, which will call all ports as per the service route map.

Eastbound, we will not have a week 3 WestMed departure ex East Coast US. Cargo will be taken on alternative services or shifted to the next WestMed departure.
